Voters should produce valid ID – PAFFREL

People's Action for Free and Fair Elections (PAFFREL) has stated that all voters who look forward to easting their votes at the 5 August General Election ought to declare their identification to the Election Commission (EC) officials on duty at the polling booths.

PAFFREL Executive Director, Rohana

Hettiatachchi, said that before casting their ballot, all voters should furnish, among others, any one of the following: their National Identity Card; a valid Passport; a valid driving licence; the State Service Retired Identification Card; the Elders Identification Card; and the Identification Card issued for members of the clergy by the Department for Registration of Persons.

He stated that if there are any persons who do not posses any of these identification cards, then he/she should forthwith contact their respective Grama Niladhari Officers or Estate Superintendents ahead of obtaining the temporary identification card issued by the EC.
